Moving ahead, we will be creating opportunities for our members to take an active part in helping shape our policies and programmes by creating more regular platforms for direct engagement. We must be better at listening to our members' needs and aspirations.

A special note of thanks to our dedicated staff who have been reaching out to members in service. I have witnessed the close bond between our members and our staff, and I encourage you to support and affirm them for their tireless contributions.

I look forward to seeing you with your family and friends at the Club.

DIALOGUE SESSION

27 May 2018, Sunday

83 members turned up for the dialogue session on 27 May 2018. President Randy Sng noted that this was the fourth one conducted during his term and observed that communication between members were in a way, more “reachable”. From this dialogue session, a consensus was reached to amend the Constitution and the ideas were brought forward to the members during the AGM. The Constitution amendment hand votes conducted at the AGM was a direct result from the discussion during the dialogue session. The various Head of Departments also shared the Financial and Performances and New Initiatives to increase revenue.



61ST ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The 61st Annual General Meeting (AGM) was held on 24 June 2018, Sunday at Kensington Ballroom. President Randy Sng started the meeting at 1.05pm, offering a warm welcome to the 439 members present, one of the largest turnouts in SGCC's history. Trustee Mr Hendrick Koh presented tokens of appreciation to all thirteen outgoing members of the General Committee who completed their terms of office.

During the President's address, he shared the highlights of some key initiatives & improvements that happened over the 2017/2018 fiscal year. The air-conditioners replacement at Heliconia Wing, the upgrading of the Atrium's kitchen exhaust system, interlocking tiles around the driveway, the retiling of the spa pools and upgrading of its control system, upgrading on bowling backend system, new gym equipment were just a few.

The President then touched on our Treasury Status with the Financial Reserves growing to \$5.66m from the previous year's \$4.99m. Cash for Operating Needs grew slightly as well, registering \$4.25m from the previous year's \$4.21m. Ending on a good note, SGCC's Cash Reserves now stands at \$9.91m, an increase from last year's \$9.20m. The President then went through the Financial Performance and Trends. The trends for Total Income, Opex, Repairs and Maintenance and Utilities have been going well since FY13/14 with the exception of FY17/18 where we see a dip in the Total Income. The President then talked about the healthy trend of our Financial Performance (Net Surplus before Depreciation and Tax and Surplus before Income) until FY17/18 where a dip was seen as well. F&B's Performance and Trends including the last five years were shown as well. S&R's Net Income Trend showed a good growth from FY13/14 all the way to FY17/18. Moving on to Jackpot, the President explained that the Fruit Machines contributed to an annual contribution of \$1.2m from FY14/15 to FY16/17. The very big dip from FY16/17 to FY17/18 was due to new Government regulations for Jackpot operations. The contribution from Jackpot is projected to be negligible for the future years. Other operating expenses and cost increases come mainly from utilities, manpower and aging infrastructure. The projected shortfall is estimated to be about \$1.5m for the coming year. He explained that balancing of the budget for FY18/19 took into consideration the input and suggestions from members over the two recent dialogue sessions conducted in April and May. In summary, the operating surplus over the last three fiscal years was \$1.45m – this was generated from the subscription increase over the early years. Two options were given to counteract the shortfall. Option One: Minimum Spending Levy (MSL) \$50 per month and \$20 subscription increase, effective from July 2018 to balance the budget for FY17/18. Option 2: Vote to change the Constitution and unlock the past three years' surplus in order to defer the MSL and subscription increase.



Election of General Committee Members

Before the commencement of the voting, the President revealed that a letter was submitted into the AOB box which was signed by 38 members, asking the Club to disclose to members who attended the AGM, the number of GC Meetings attended by the current GC members during July 2016 and June 2017 as well as July 2017 to June 2018. The information on the nominees' length of years as members was requested as well. He disclosed that it was the view of the General Committee who convened and discussed that the information was to be provided to the members attending the 61st AGM and flashed the information on the screens provided.

As of 16 June 2018, a total of 33 nominations were received for the thirteen vacant positions. Each candidate was given three minutes to campaign for themselves and their team and once all candidates were finished, the President commenced the voting.



Confirmation of Minutes and Adoption of Accounts

The AGM proceeded with the confirmation of the minutes of the 60th AGM. Mr Thomas Cheok proposed the confirmation of the minutes whilst Ms Molly Chua seconded it. Before the adoption of the accounts, the President brought to everybody's attention and apologized for the mistake on Page 76 of the Annual Report, under point 9, Net Accumulated Funds at end of year should be read without the brackets. The House then proceeded to adopt the Accounts as well with Ms Catherine Lim Ping Er proposing it and Mr Lee Phee Teck seconding it. Honorary Treasurer Ms Wong Sook Yee proposed to endorse our current auditors HLB Atrede LLP for the ensuing year with Mr Tony Lim seconding it.



Resolutions

Unlocking the operating surplus of the past three years

Past President Mr Thomas Tan wanted to clarify if this meant that the balance of the financial reserves (made up of entrance, transfer fees and 10% of budget surplus) is being made available. Committee Member Mr Koh Jin Kit and Honorary Treasurer Ms Wong Sook Yee explained that 10% of the net operating surplus goes into the financial reserves and the balance goes to operating expenses. The resolution was carried with 113 in favour and 2 against.

Transferability of Membership

The House moved to reclassify transfer fees to be part of the operating income. Mr Tony Lim wanted to know what the quantum of next of kin transfers per year. Ms Wong Sook Yee explained that the transfer fee of \$8,800 is only applicable for third party transfers; the admin fee of \$107 w/GST is for the membership transfer between family members. She then put forth the number of transfers per year between ordinary members was in the region of 400. The resolution was carried with 124 in favour and 1 against.

Core Values

The President went on to talk about Core Values that support the vision and mission, shape the culture and reflecting what SGCC values. He sincerely hopes that the next GC and members adopt these values of Respect, Integrity, Graciousness, Honesty and Trust. He then appealed to members to build these core values that will become part of the SGCC culture.
