Dear Members ,

This year has flown by so quickly and it has provided us with many opportunities to learn and grow.

DISRUPTIVE INNOVATION - coined by Clayton M. Christensen.

In business, a disruptive innovation is an innovation that creates a new market and value network and eventually disrupts an existing market and value network, displacing established market-leading firms, products, and alliances.

Management has reconfigured the use of our staff resources more efficiently by avoiding duplication in duties as well as providing new opportunities for staff to excel further both personally and professionally.

There has also been movement within our General Committee with several resignations. We would like to thank them for their time and sense of volunteerism.

In view of this, we have appointed three new individuals who have kindly agreed to further help steer the club strategically with their skills and experience. The new additions are: Mr. Daniel Ho (Committee Member), Mr. George Lim (Committee Member) and Mr. Jack Rodrigues (Committee Member).

The club’s lawyers have confirmed that this provision is made available in our Club’s Constitution, (Clause 24.3):

- a. Any member of the Committee may vacate office during his term of office; and
- b. Should any member vacate his office, the Committee may, at its sole discretion, by appointment fill the resulting vacancy, except that in the case of the President, Honorary Secretary or Honorary Treasurer, the Vice-President, Assistant Honorary Secretary or Assistant Honorary Treasurer will take over.

The dialogue that we held on 26th November was well attended and this will be a feature that we will do more of, so as to share information and listen better to the needs of all our members.

With the Christmas season upon us, let’s take the time to enjoy the many festive offerings that our Club has to offer. This includes special themed events for the whole family and sumptuous gourmet food, lovingly prepared for members to order and enjoy.

Looking ahead, 2019 is going to be an exciting year with a variety of new offerings already in the works so stay tuned.

Finally, thank you everyone, members, staff, the General Committee for your engagement, support and for all that you do to benefit the Club. We could not have accomplished the things that we did without you.

SAFETY IN THE CLUB

In bid to tighten security in the Club, we require all guests who enter the Club without an accompanying members to register with security at the guardhouse. We urge members to be cooperative and inform their guests of this procedure. A gentle reminder that members are still required to sign in their guests, whether it is to use the facilities, or enjoy the entertainment and dining options. Bye-laws shall be complied by the member and the member's guest (s).

COFFEE DELI SEATING

We would like to seek members' and their guest (s)' cooperation in stowing their belongings in the lockers when they are swimming. There has been a lot of feedback of members placing their bags at the Coffee Deli's tables and chairs, preventing other members from dining at the Deli. We seek your cooperation on this, so that there will be sufficient seats for other members as well.

USE OF CLUB AMENITIES

When using amenities provided by the Club (tissue, toilet paper, hand soap etc.), please be considerate and use only what you need. A gentle reminder that the amenities in the Club are meant to be used in the Club only.

CLUB'S PROPERTY

A gentle reminder of Bye-Law clause 7.8 pertaining to Club's property. No members, family members or guests shall remove any club property (including newspapers and magazines) from the premises. Those removing or damaging any Club property shall pay for making good the same. The cost shall be assessed by the General Manager whose decision shall be final.



ATTIRE IN THE CLUB'S LOBBY

The use of swimwear should be confined to the main swimming pool complex and adjoining outdoor areas. Should you require to be in the lobby or at the lobby or at other indoor areas of the Club after a swim, do dry off, put on some clothing or a swim robe and footwear before making your way there.



SUPERVISION OF CHILDREN

As stated in the Club's Bye-Laws clause 4.3 Children under 12 years old may enter the Club's premises and use the facilities only when accompanied by the member, an adult family member or an authorized childminder. All authorised childminders must be registered with the Club. Members are responsible for their children's and childminders' behaviour and conduct at all times while on the club's premises.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Under Bye-Law clause 8.1 Only food and drink purchased from the Club may be consumed within the Club's premises. Exceptions to this rule may include duty-paid wine, hard liquor, birthday cake, wedding cake or anniversary cake. Such wine and hard liquor brought for private functions are subject to corkage charge. A member found not to have complied with this bye-law shall be subject to a penalty charge.

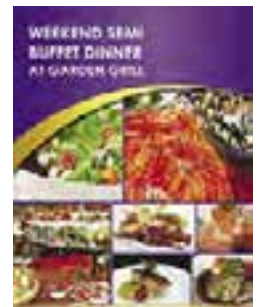

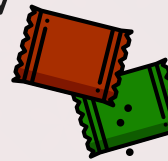

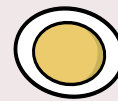
