Here are a few transgressions commonly encountered by Security Staff. The Club is hoping to seek the full cooperation of members in adhering to them:

- A) Children should be supervised at all times for their safety as well as the avoidance of disturbance to other members. *(View Clause 2.3 & 4.3)*
- B) Members hosting guests are required to sign-in their guests upon entering the Club *(View Clause 5)*
- C) Outside food and beverage are not allowed to be consumed at the Club. *(View Clause 8)*
- D) Membership Cards are only to be used by the member, whose named is stated on the card, and cannot be used by another person. *(View Clause 11)*
- E) Only Member registered vehicles will be allowed entry to members' car park. Guests will not have the privilege of parking at the members' car park even upon request of a member. Guests have to park their vehicle at the designated visitor lots available.





There was even a lucky draw and the 1st prize of a Fitbit Versa Smart Fitness Watch went to the lucky David Foo.






