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Dear Members,

We piloted our first focus group discussion on 8 April 2017. Members were updated on the Club's financial performance and upcoming initiatives by the various departments. It was a fruitful session as it provided an opportunity for members, the General Committee (GC) and Management to collaborate and work towards improving the Club. I would like to thank members who attended the session for their active participation. More details on issues raised and the follow-up actions are on page 8. As we continue to work towards the betterment of the Club, I would like to invite members who wish to contribute their areas of expertise to participate in future sessions. Topics include sports, food and beverage, membership, security, facilities, maintenance and safety. Members can register their interest with the Membership Relations department.

To provide convenience and enhance members' experience at the Club, we installed a modern Electronic Parking System (EPS) counter as well as repaired the surface of the Club's driveway to correct the unevenness and replaced some of the interlocking bricks. More umbrella shades were added at the poolside area to provide shade and shelter to members.

You may be aware of the increase in water price announced by the government during Budget 2017 in February. With water prices going up by 30%, the Club foresees that its expenses will also go up. I would like to assure members that the Club will not be passing on the price increase to members for the current financial year (April 2017 to March 2018). Additionally, electricity tariffs have increased by an average of 6.1 per cent since April 2017 as announced by the Singapore Power (SP) Group. As part of our cost containment efforts, we managed to negotiate for better electricity rates with a new vendor. Nevertheless, I would like to seek members' cooperation to be more conservative when using water and electricity in the Club.

Over the past two months, we had an active calendar of events. We hosted the TCA Junior Invitational Chess Championship on 14 April 2017 with over 200 attendees. We received great compliments from participants on a wonderful experience. Our Senior bowling team brought home their second consecutive championship title at the Senior Inter-Club Bowling Mixed League. We recently brought over 80 participants to Bekok, Malaysia, where they enjoyed a day of sightseeing and shopping. We will be organising another trip to Malaysia for durians and shopping in the coming months, do join us.

This June, celebrate Father's Day at the Club with a good meal. Enjoy mouthwatering set-menus at the Garden Grill or indulge in a sumptuous steamboat buffet at the Atrium Cafe and Coffee Deli. Fitness enthusiasts are in for a treat too as we will be taking you on a cycling adventure to Batam, Indonesia, to enjoy its natural beauty, lush jungle and mesmerising seafront. For those less inclined to the great outdoors, we will be having a new workout class, High-Intensity Interval Training (HIIT).

We have been working on creating more activities to engage members of all ages. In late June, we will be bringing an interesting marketplace to the Club. Be on the lookout for handmade knick knacks, fashion items, snacks as well as lifestyle products. In August, we will be celebrating the nation's 52nd birthday with a carnival and a family fun walk. We will

also be launching our very first SGCC Coffee Table Book titled *Serangoon Gardens Country Club: Our Heritage, Our Pride, Our Future.* I would like to take this opportunity to thank members for their kind contributions in making this book a dream come true.

Our financial year has just ended on 31 March 2017, I am pleased to report that the Club has been operating in accordance with the Treasury Safeguarding Framework (TSF). The Club's financial reserve had accrued a year-on-year increase of \$0.781 million to \$4.993 million. The Club's cash reserves (financial reserve and working capital) had reached \$9.205 million, which was \$1.326 million higher than a year before.

The Club also did relatively well with a net surplus of \$2.151 million, this represents a year-on-year increase of \$263k. After factoring in the depreciation, gain/loss on disposal of property, plant, equipment and tax; the net surplus was \$701k compared to a surplus of \$360k in the previous year. Total income registered a modest year-on-year decrease of 0.66% to \$7.681 million, largely due to the decrease in F&B contribution, transfer fees and car park fees. This decrease was partially offset by the increase in subscription fees, entrance fees, interest income and fruit machine contribution. We still managed to contain our expenditure and witnessed a decrease by \$314k to \$5.530 million. This savings came from operating and administrative expenses, water and electricity charges as well as repair and maintenance cost.

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) is just around the corner. It will be held on Saturday, 24 June 2017, at Kensington Ballroom 1 at 1pm. I would like to encourage members with voting rights to attend. Lunch will be served from 11.30am onwards. I look forward to your attendance.


STAFF APPRECIATION DAY 27 March 2017

FOCUS GROUP DISCUSSION 8 April 2017

The objectives of the pilot focus group discussion (FGD) were to present insights on the Club's development and to hear the thoughts and ideas from the diverse, talented pool of members from different professions so as to bring about betterment of the Club.

President Randy Sng, who chaired the FGD, shared with the attendees the Club's financial performance, which revealed healthy trends, especially the Club's effort in extending assets' life spans. The Membership Relations chairperson and moderator, Mr Terrence Fernandez, then introduced the various Heads of Departments, who shared highlights of their departments and upcoming initiatives.

Many members expressed appreciation of the Club's efforts to more proactively engage members and the positive outcomes that have resulted from similar discussions. In sum, it was a fruitful session with attendees exchanging various ideas in a lively and constructive manner.

Here are the key points brought up during the discussion and the follow-up actions taken by the Club:

Publicity platforms

Apart from the *ClubSpirit* magazine and supplement, the Club's communication platforms also include SMS, electronic newsletters, social media (Facebook and Instagram). For SMS and electronic newsletters, under the Personal Data Protection Act, members are required to opt in to receive such publicity materials from the Club. We encourage members to update their interest(s) with us, so that we can update you on all the upcoming activities and promotions. Forms are available at all F&B outlets, Main Reception, PC Kiosk, Jackpot Room, Gym and Gardens Bowl. Alternatively, opt in at www.sgcc.com. sg/news-events/keep-me-posted.

Bringing back vibrancy to the Club

adding We experimented with entertainment to off-peak periods through a Weekday Entertainment programme at Crossroads Lounge. The Management will also be embarking on a series of activities and programmes to boost patronage, especially among those who have not been coming to the Club. For example, more emphasis could be placed on interest groups, which may help participants feel more at ease, attracting them to come to the Club more often. Relevant interest groups may also be tapped upon to save cost for the Club, as opposed to hiring external vendors to help out at Club-organised events.

Lightning alert system

A common misconception is that lightning only occurs when there is rain. With Singapore having one of the highest rates of lightning activity, to ensure that members enjoy the facilities in a safe manner, the Club has put in place a lightning alert system. When lightning activity is detected, the siren and flashing lights will be activated. Club-wide public announcements will be made and the staff will also advise members to proceed indoors. Once it is safe to resume outdoor activities, the siren and lights will be activated once more, followed by an explanatory announcement. To further safeguard members' safety, 3 beacon lights have been added to serve as additional warning to members around the pool area.

Minimum spending

The President reiterated that due mainly to the recent increase in subscription fees, the General Committee does not intend to implement the minimum spending in the short term. Nevertheless, the Club will look into setting up a task group to explore the idea, possibly inviting some of the attendees to contribute their area of expertise. Members may also register their interest with the Membership Relations department to be part of this task group.
