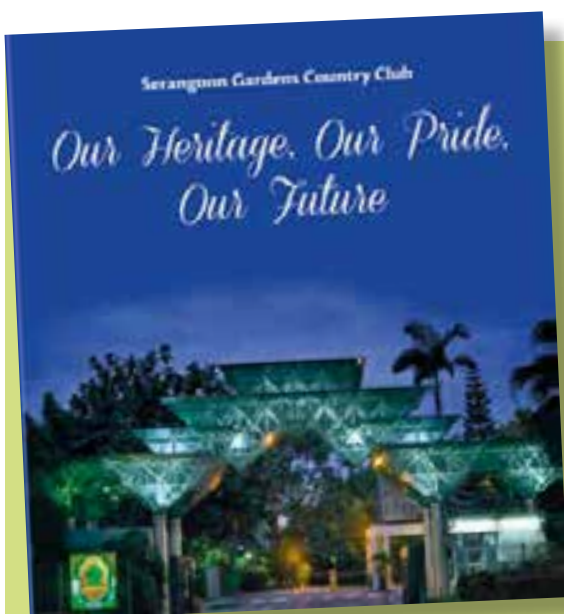

CHANGES TO SGCC GIRO ARRANGEMENT

With effect from August 2017, the Club has switched its GIRO collection from Citibank to UOB for the deduction of members' monthly statement of account. Some members may have received notification from their banks regarding the change in GIRO arrangement; no further action is required.



CHANGES TO JACKPOT ROOM REGULATIONS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE POLICE LICENSING DEPARTMENT (PLD) FOR FRUIT MACHINE OPERATIONS

With effect from 1 November 2017, the new Fruit Machine Permit and regulations require that the following be observed:

- The Jackpot Room is only opened to members aged 21 and above, strictly no guests are allowed
- Persons must be a member of the Club for at least one (1) year
- Written consent must be given by members who enter the Jackpot Room, for the Club to verify their exclusion status with the National Council on Problem Gambling (NCPG), and for NCPG to release such information to the Club at the point of entry to the Jackpot Room
- Members must present their membership cards and NRICs upon entry and must register their particulars and time of arrival at and departure from the Jackpot Room

A copy of the form can be obtained from the Main Reception, Security Guardhouse and Gym Counter.

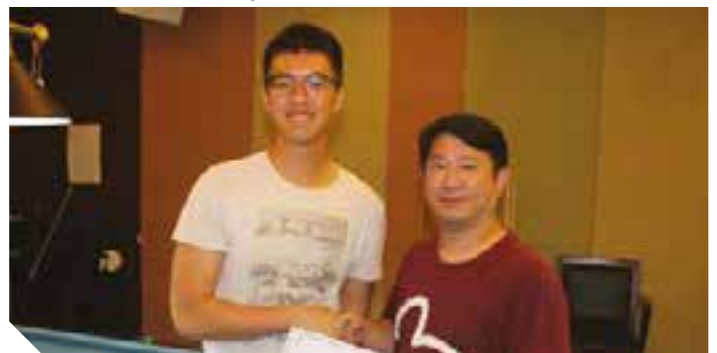

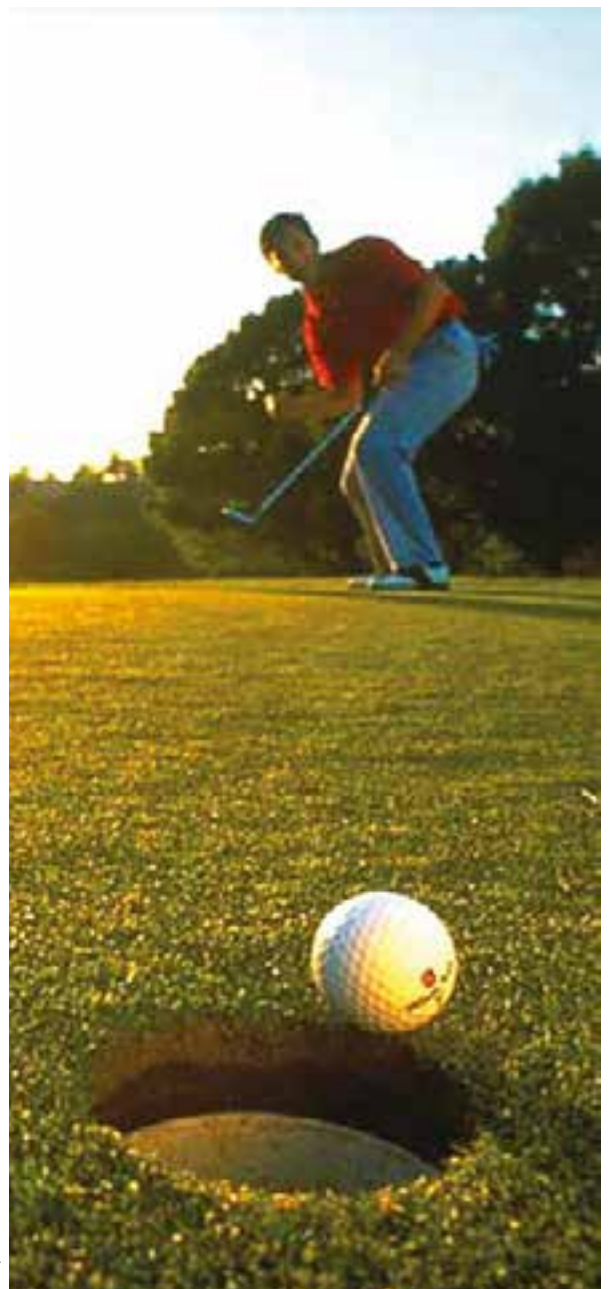
