Rules & Regulations

- 1. Gardeners are responsible for their own safety
- 2. Only well rotted organic manure and organic fertilisers are to be used. Poisons and chemicals such as weed or bug killers are not allowed. Urination and defecation on the open ground is not allowed
- 3. No sharp objects (scissors, knives, etc) should be left unattended at the garden
- 4. Pathways are to be kept clear of equipment or garden debris at all times to ensure no tripping hazards
- 5. All garden tools or objects should be taken away when a gardener leaves the garden. Gardeners are responsible for their own personal garden tools and should mark them for easy identification
- 6. Gardeners should ensure that there is no stagnant water within the garden area so as to prevent any mosquito breeding
- 7. The garden must be kept neat and tidy at all times
- 8. No smoking at the Community Garden
- 9. No consumption of alcohol at the Community Garden
- 10. The Club will not be held liable for any damages, loss, injury or claim that occurs in connection with the Community
- 11. If you see a hazard, unsafe condition, or situation that could result in injury or ill health, please notify the Club immediately. Do not take matters into your own hands

Safety Guidelines

- 1. Wear appropriate clothing and shoes whilst working on site. Do not wear open-toed shoes or high heels. Wear a hat in hot weather. Use the correct protective equipment such as goggles, gloves and masks for the particular work
- 2. Remember to always stay hydrated by drinking lots of water
- 3. Be aware of your limitations, never carry more than you can comfortably manage, and get help if needed. Best to work in a group
- 4. Wash your hands after working at the garden, and before eating or drinking
- 5. Locker keys can be drawn from the Guard House, person withdrawing the key need to sign out and sign in when returning the key
- 6. First aid box will be provided and to be kept at the locker at all time

Please take note of the following Rules & Regulations as well as Safety Guidelines

Rules & Regulations

- 1. Gardeners are responsible for their own safety and well-being
- 2. Only organic manure, organic fertiliser and organic pesticides are permitted for use. Chemical pesticides are strictly forbidden
- 3. Gardeners are to practice good housekeeping and keep pathways free of equipment and debris at all times to prevent tripping
- 4. Only plants approved by the Gardening Interest Group are permitted to be grown at the designated plots in the garden
- 5. No sharp objects (scissors, knives, etc) should be left unattended in the garden
- 6. Gardeners are to ensure all flower pots and containers are properly stowed to prevent water collection and mosquito breeding
- 7. Smoking and alcohol consumption are strictly forbidden in the garden
- 8. Report any hazard, unsafe condition or situation that could result in injury or loss to the Club for immediate action
- 9. All materials and tools purchased with Club funds are strictly for use in the garden

Safety Guidelines

- 1. Wear appropriate clothing and non-slip covered shoes when working in the garden. Use protective equipment such as goggles, gloves, hats and masks, as appropriate
- 2. Adopt correct carrying posture when carrying loads. Do not carry any load heavier than what you can manage
