

Pierre Jean 2021

CHARDONNAY, COLUMBARD

France

A brilliant clear pale yellow/greenish color. Aromas of ripe apples & sliced pears with the Chardonnay characteristics contributing to the hints of tropical fruits. Fruit-driven freshness on the palate with balanced acidity and smooth finishing.

MERLOT

France

Deep ruby colour; raspberry, dark plum and earth aromas; dry, medium-bodied with good acidity and light tannin; flavours of earth, plum, cherry and blackberry; medium-long finish.

Ca'Vescovo Prosecco DOC Brut NV

GLERA

Veneto, Italy

Bright pale straw-yellow; A fine, clear mousse with attractively intense, very fruity and aromatic, with hints of wisteria flowers and Rennet apples. Very well-balanced and appealing, with the extremely delicate almond note that is typical of Glera.

JL Vergnon Conversation Blanc de Blanc NV

CHARDONNAY

Champagne, France

In the heart of the chalk wonderland that is Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Didier Vergnon and his son Clement are the 4th and 5th generations to lead this small 5-hectare estate. Classic Côte des Blancs Chardonnay, with everything you want from the terroir. Crisp green apple, with a vertical nose. The front end is warm and chalky front with an impressive weight of green fruit on the palate and a really nice sugar delivery.

White Bottles

Fusional of Malborough 2019

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Wairau Valley, New Zealand

This organically grown wine is when French know-how meets New Zealand terroir. Domaine Laporte of Sancerre in Loire, France have fused the terroir of Marlborough, New Zealand with their historical know-how, producing a wine of luscious fruit and lovely roundness. Both subtle and intense in the mouth, this wine expresses a pleasant freshness, allied to delicate notes of ripe fruit such as apricot or pineapple.

Jean Claude Chatelain Pouilly Fume Chailloux 2019

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Loire, France

The Chatelain family has worked the vineyards of Pouilly-sur-Loire since the 1630s. Today the family farm is run by the 12th generation of winemakers. The grapes for Les Chailloux are grown on the St. Andelain Hill with its clay and siliceous soils strewn with pebbles and flint. Light yellow-gold; the wine is vivid, aromatic and minerally on the nose, followed by a spicy flint character on the palate.

Los Vascos 2022

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Colchagua, Chile

Los Vascos is located in the Colchagua region, Chile. Nestled between the Andes and the Coastal Mountain Range. Owned by Barons de Rothschild (Lafite) it combines Chilean traditions with DBR Lafite's heritage and expertise. This wine presents a pale yellow colour with glints of green, aromas of melon, green apple, pineapple, and lime are underscored by spicy, herby notes such as lemongrass and lemon verbena.



Los Vascos 2022

CHARDONNAY

Colchagua, Chile

Another white from Los Vascos owned by Barons de Rothschild (Lafite). This wine has a beautiful pale bright yellow. The nose offers the distinctive pineapple, peach, and banana scents of this variety, as well as notes of pear, grapefruit, and elegant floral aromas. Rich, creamy texture, good length, and excellent acidity.

Bernard Defaix Chablis 2022

CHARDONNAY

Burgundy, France

When we talk about a classic Chablis profile, this is it – bone-dry and crisp with sunshiny bright acid, a violin twang of high-wire citrus and ripe yellow apple flavours with a smart, mineral finish.

The Defaix family is a fourth generation of a family of vine-growers rich in personality.

From 2012, they have been producing organic wines.

The Paring 2020

CHARDONNAY

Central Coast, California, USA

This classic oaky Californian Chardonnay offers light aromas of lemon custard, pear and a touch of smoke on the nose. The palate combines zesty acidity with ripe apple and lime flavours, all presented with a chalky texture. If you like rich white wines, with spicy and buttery character but also with lemony acidity then this will become your favourite.

Markus Molitor Haus Klosterberg 2020

RIESLING

Mosel, Germany

Markus Molitor chooses the grapes for this Riesling from steep, old vineyard sites in the Mosel, characterised by a great variety of slate soils. The Haus Klosterberg is an off-dry wine which represents a typical Mosel Riesling in perfect balance: fruitiness, acidity and minerality. Its clear, fresh and delicate fruity aromas are balanced out by its minerality, piquant feel and complex body.

Red Bottles

Sevenhill Inigo 2019

SHIRAZ

Clare Valley, Australia

Sevenhill was established in 1851 when the Jesuits who settled in the area planted vines to produce sacramental wine. It is the first winery in the Clare Valley and one of the oldest in Australia. This Shiraz is sourced from nine individual blocks with some of these blocks over 100 years ago and several planted in the 1970's. Impressive depth of colour. Aromas of toasted nuts, coffee and spice, combined with dark fruits, juniper berry and prunes. The fruit sweetness is well-integrated, with gritty tannins and a fine, long savoury finish.

Amelia Park Trellis 2017

SHIRAZ

Frankland River, Australia

This wine is made with fruit from the Frankland River Region of Western Australia, which produces wine with great richness of flavour. Displays lovely mulberry, mocha and spicy notes. The palate is luscious with cherry and plum flavours, supported by smooth tannins.

Jean-Luc Colombo Saint Joseph "Les Lauves" 2018

SHIRAZ

Northern Rhone, France

Family-owned and run by Jean Luc, wife Anne and daughter Laure, they are certified organic ECOCERT since 2012. Wild and yet captivating, "Les Lauves" (Cézannes's art studio) comes from Syrah vines grown on the granitic slopes of the Saint-Joseph appellation in Northern Rhone. This wine is dense, it has a full-bodied structure with intense aromas of spices and violets.

Chateau Tahbilk "Old Vines" 2017

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, SHIRAZ

Victoria, Australia

Characteristic of its aged vine with a contributing average vine age of over 35 years, this blend of 51% Cabernet Sauvignon and 49% Shiraz is deeply packed with layers of dark and red berry fruits that are teased out with eucalypt, Chinese five spice, earth and dark chocolate notes. Herbal and cedar hints from time spent in American and French oak taking that complexity further, with savoury tannins on the finish.

Bodega Caro Petit Caro 2019

MALBEC, CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Mendoza, Argentina

A joint Venture between Barons de Rothschild (Lafite) and Nicolas Catena working with a blend of 67% native Argentinian Malbec and 33% Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine has a deep ruby colour. The nose is expressive with notes of raspberries, coffee and figs. Complex and juicy on the palate with aromas of plums, fruit and spices.

Montes Alpha 2020

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Colchagua, Chile

The Marchigüe vineyards, is in an undulating landscape that ends in the Pacific Ocean (25 km away), where the grapes mature slowly under the influence of a colder temperatures. Intense ripe red fruit, cherries in syrup, and blackcurrants are underpinned by hints of nutmeg and rich toast on a palate with good structure and a long, elegant finish.

Glenelly Estate Reserve Red Blend 2015

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, SYRAH

Stellenbosch, South Africa

Stellenbosch is arguably the winemaking hub of South Africa. Glenelly, with its roots in French viticulture and vineyards on the slopes of Simonsberg Mountain, has truly tapped into the potential of the terroir here. The Estate Reserve Red is Glenelly's signature blend. Supple and rich in the mouth, this wine is bursting with flavors of ripe, dark berries, floral spice, shaved cocoa and a hint of roasted pepper.

Los Vascos Cromas Gran Reserve 2018

CABERNET FRANC

Colchagua, Chile

Los Vascos wines try to bring a bit of the Lafite tradition to the terroir of Chile. The property is the vision of Barons de Rothschild (Lafite), who arrived in Chile in 1988. This 100% Cabernet Franc stands out for its deep crimson colour and aroma of dark fruit, cherry and spice. On the palate, it offers a full and well-balanced body with notes of blackcurrant, raspberry and vanilla. The wine has been aged for 18 months in oak barrels, which gives it a touch of smoky complexity.

Cassagne et Vitailles - Combarels A La Lumiere Terrasses du Larzac 2019

GRENACHE

Languedoc-Roussillon, France

This juicy grenache from the heart of Languedoc reflects the complexity and richness of the great terroirs of the south of France. It has wild blackberry, wild strawberry and more slightly wild redcurrants associated with touches of liquorice, rosemary, scrubland, an almost minty touch. It has a seductive full-to medium-bodied with attractive fruit and a fresh finish.

The Paring Santa Rita Hill 2019

PINOT NOIR

Central Coast, California, USA

A smooth and deeply fruited Pinot Noir, the wine enraptures the minute it hits the glass. Its bright red fruit mixes with a hint of plum and spice on the nose. This is a bolder style of Pinot Noir, but it will more than satisfy those who crave nuance and refinement. The palate is round, soft and harmonious with spicy red cherry intermingling with the right amount of oak.

This is truly a best-in-class Pinot Noir.



Nittardi Belcanto Chianti Classico DOCGS 2019

SANGIOVESE

Tuscany, Italy

This elegant wine is made entirely from the Sangiovese grape, which is known for its acidic, tannic nature. The wine is aged for 18 months in French oak barrels to attain an appealing complexity. Rich ruby-red colour, juicy cherry, raspberry and spicy aromas with hints of Mediterranean herbs and floral notes on the nose. Medium bodied with soft and juicy tannins on the palate and a fresh and velvet finish.

St Gayan Chateauneuf de Pape 2016

GRENACHE, MOURVEDRE, CLAIRETTE, SYRAH

Southern Rhone, France

What a glorious Chateauneuf this is. It is 90% Grenache with the rest being Mourvèdre, Clairette and Syrah. The nose has so much grainy red fruit along with uplifting minerals and floral hints, that it is the essence of CDP boiled down. Cool minerals finish with licorice and some anise adding complexity to the youthful vigour. So utterly classic with explosive and freshly defined red berry fruit.

Glenelly Lady May 2016

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, PETIT VERDOT

Stellenbosch, South Africa

In 2003, Glenelly was bought by May-Eliane de Lencquesaing, who for over 30 years, had been the owner of the classed growth Bordeaux, Château Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande in Pauillac. Named after her, Lady May is Glenelly's flagship wine. Expect to taste flavours of cassis, blackcurrant, dark cherry, a touch of graphite and delicate, spicy plum fruit. Fresh and vibrant, Lady May is the definitive introduction to Glenelly's terroir.

Chateau Quinault l'Enclos 2014

MERLOT, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CABERNET FRANC

St Emillon, France

Château Quinault is in the heart of Libourne, St Emillon. Under Pierre Lurton of Château Cheval Blanc, the goal is to imitate the viticulture, winemaking, and aging process of its more famous brother Chateau. Terroir of Château Quinault l'Enclos is spread over 20 hectares of sand and pebbles mixed with a little clay. The vine plants are on average 45 years old, are 71.5% Merlot, 14.5% Cabernet Franc, and 14% Cabernet Sauvignon, typical of the varieties in the region.

Monte Campo Amarone Valpolicella 2016

CORVINA

Veneto, Italy

Amarone needs no introduction and is widely recognized as one of Italy's iconic red wines. The process used to make Amarone is known as *appassimento*, in which the harvested grapes are air-dried in a temperature and humidity-controlled room for about three months. The resulting grapes lose much of their natural water, and shrivel, looking a bit like raisins resulting in a powerful wine of almost 16% alcohol content and more.

Artadi Valdegines 2019

TEMPRANILLO

Rioja, Spain

The single plot Valdegines is located in Laguardia in Rioja Alavesa and was 100% planted with Tempranillo in 1989. The site has a steep slope with a low support of sand and clay over the limestone. The nose is incredibly dark, deep and seductive. A little cinnamon, as well as delicate hints of coconut and black pepper lie above the fruit. On the palate, it is compact and full-bodied. Literally a "mouthful of wine", but in the best possible way.

In addition to the juicy fruit, it presents a very fine tannin.





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
