## MonteCampo Delle Venezie 2023

PINOT GRIGIO

**Italy**

Straw-yellow appealing, brilliant reflections. It is a wine of great elegance, offering aromas of good intensity. It offers scents of white flowers combined with those of slightly green apples. The flavor is no less satisfying, superbly balanced and persistent. The aftertaste is delicate.

Brilliant, attractive and warm ruby-red colour. Ample and remarkably complex, with vinous and characteristic tones. Dry on the palate and gracious, with delicate and soft veining, a fine and harmonious balance.

# Bubbly Bottles

## Ca'Vescovo Prosecco DOC Brut NV

GLERA

**Veneto, Italy**

Bright pale straw-yellow; A fine, clear mousse with attractively intense, very fruity and aromatic, with hints of wisteria flowers and Rennet apples. Very well-balanced and appealing, with the extremely delicate almond note that is typical of Glera.

## Devaux Cuvee D Brut NV

PINOT NOIR/CHARDONNAY

**Champagne, France**

Gold yellow colour with delicate and persistent mousse. White blossom and soft spices appear first on the nose, mellowed by notes of toasted brioche and vanilla on the finish. Presents freshness with mandarin and orange zest notes.

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# White Bottles

## Los Vascos 2023

SAUVIGNON BLANC

**Colchagua, Chile**

Los Vascos is located in the Colchagua region, Chile. Nestled between the Andes and the Coastal Mountain Range. Owned by Barons de Rothschild (Lafite) it combines Chilean traditions with DBR Lafite's heritage and expertise. This wine presents a pale yellow colour with glints of green, aromas of melon, green apple, pineapple, and lime are underscored by spicy, herby notes such as lemongrass and lemon verbena.

## Thanisch Estate Kabinett Weingut 2019

RIESLING

**Mosel, Germany**

Pronounced bite of acidic tension and a salty tang on the finish, which works brilliantly with the slaty minerality. The precise finish is rounded out by a lovely fleshy fruit residue coating the palate. Textbook high quality Kabinett, seriously good.

## Los Vascos 2024

CHARDONNAY

**Colchagua, Chile**

Another white from Los Vascos owned by Barons de Rothschild (Lafite). This wine has a beautiful pale bright yellow. The nose offers the distinctive pineapple, peach, and banana scents of this variety, as well as notes of pear, grapefruit, and elegant floral aromas. Rich, creamy texture, good length, and excellent acidity.

## Pio Cesare L'Altro 2022

CHARDONNAY

**Piedmont, Italy**

'L'Altro' is the Italian version for 'The Other'. This wine is named 'L'Altro' in order to distinguish it from the first Chardonnay ever produced - Piodilei. Very fresh and fruity, with great minerality and a slight vanilla note.

## Domaine Francois Carillon Bourgogne 2021

CHARDONNAY

**Burgundy, France**

The Carillon family have been growing grapes in Puligny-Montrachet, south of Côte de Beaune for almost 500 years. In 2010, the estate was split between the two brothers, Francois and Jacques and since then Francois has been blazing his own path. We present this Bourgogne from his boutique estate.

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# Red Bottles

## Sevenhill Inigo 2019

SHIRAZ

**Clare Valley, Australia**

Sevenhill was established in 1851 when the Jesuits who settled in the area planted vines to produce sacramental wine. It is the first winery in the Clare Valley and one of the oldest in Australia. This Shiraz is sourced from nine individual blocks with some of these blocks over 100 years ago and several planted in the 1970's. Impressive depth of colour. Aromas of toasted nuts, coffee and spice, combined with dark fruits, juniper berry and prunes. The fruit sweetness is well-integrated, with gritty tannins and a fine, long savoury finish.

## Amelia Park 2022

SHIRAZ

**Frankland River, Australia**

This wine is made with fruit from the Frankland River Region of Western Australia, which produces wine with great richness of flavour. Displays lovely mulberry, mocha and spicy notes. The palate is luscious with cherry and plum flavours, supported by smooth tannins.

## Bodegas Caro Amancaya 2021

MALBEC, CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**Mendoza, Argentina**

Deep velvety red color with intense ruby hues. Very fruity and fresh on the nose, followed by aromas of red fruit, strawberry and black currant. On the palate, the wine is long, well balanced and pleasant, with refined tannins. Displaying generous aromas of red berries.

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## Glenelly Estate Reserve Red Blend 2015

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, SYRAH

**Stellenbosch, South Africa**

Stellenbosch is arguably the winemaking hub of South Africa. Glenelly, with its roots in French viticulture and vineyards on the slopes of Simonsberg Mountain, has truly tapped into the potential of the terroir here. The Estate Reserve Red is Glenelly's signature blend. Supple and rich in the mouth, this wine is bursting with flavors of ripe, dark berries, floral spice, shaved cocoa and a hint of roasted pepper.

## Los Vascos Cromas Gran Reserva 2020

CABERNET FRANC

**Colchagua, Chile**

Los Vascos wines try to bring a bit of the Lafite tradition to the terroir of Chile. The property is the vision of Barons de Rothschild (Lafite), who arrived in Chile in 1988. This 100% Cabernet Franc stands out for its deep crimson colour and aroma of dark fruit, cherry and spice. On the palate, it offers a full and well-balanced body with notes of blackcurrant, raspberry and vanilla. The wine has been aged for 18 months in oak barrels, which gives it a touch of smoky complexity.

## Pio Cesare d'Alba 2022

BARBERA

**Piedmont, Italy**

The Barbera grapes are sourced from the Barolo and Barbaresco region. A classic Barbera with a uniquely great structure, full-bodied, complex, smooth character, ripe fruit, spices and a very long life.

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## Nittardi Belcanto Chianti Classico DOCGS 2020

**SANGIOVESE**

**Tuscany, Italy**

This elegant wine is made entirely from the Sangiovese grape, which is known for its acidic, tannic nature. The wine is aged for 18 months in French oak barrels to attain an appealing complexity. Rich ruby-red colour, juicy cherry, raspberry and spicy aromas with hints of Mediterranean herbs and floral notes on the nose. Medium bodied with soft and juicy tannins on the palate and a fresh and velvet finish.

## Rosso Di Montalcino Ridolfi 2020

**SANGIOVESE**

**Tuscany, Italy**

Rosso di Montalcino, often called the “baby Brunello” was recognized as a DOC in 1984, proposing itself as a more agile and equally excellent wine compared to its older brother Brunello. Tenuta Ridolfi’s vineyards are on the North-East slope of the Montalcino hill. Made from 100% Sangiovese the wine was aged for 12 months in large Slavonian oak barrels.

## Moulin De La Gardette Gigondas Cuvee Tradition 2021

**GRENACHE, MOURVÈDRE, AND SYRAH**

**Rhone, France**

Moulin de La Gardette is located in a spot reputed since as early as 1670 for the quality of its vineyards on the rocky slopes of la Gardette, just to the south of the village of Gigondas. Jean-Baptiste Meunier is a fifth-generation vineyard owner and he makes just 3 wines and the Tradition which we are presenting is his flagship.

## Tardieu-Laurent Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2021

**GRENACHE, SYRAH, MOURVEDRE, CINSAULT**

**Southern Rhone, France**

Grenache (75%), syrah (10%), mourvèdre (10%) and cinsault (5%).

The 2021 vintage is special! It had challenges posed by late and often severe frost, an exceptionally wet spring, and an unpredictable and lacklustre summer. But eventually Mother Nature saved the day and in the words of Michel Tardieu: "Like every year, nature decides for us. This is what makes this job beautiful and delicate. But undeniably, 2021 will remain forever the vintage of a great "vigneron" (vine grower)"

## Domaine Cyrot-Buthiau Bourgogne 2020

**PINOT NOIR**

**Burgundy, France**

Brothers Marc-Emmanuel and Olivier Cyrot are the fourth winemaking generation of this family domaine. This Bourgogne comes from declassified Pommard vineyards. Great value! This delicious

Pinot has a wonderfully perfumed nose immediately inviting you in and offers a burst of juicy strawberry and red cherry flavours on the palate. It's fresh and vibrant and, while tasty now, will no doubt continue to age well in bottles.

## Le Cupole IGT Tenuta di Trinoro 2019

**MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, PETIT VERDOT**

**Tuscany, Italy**

It has a brilliant ruby color. The nose gives a fresh aroma with spicy notes and pleasant aromas of ripe cherries. In the mouth it appears fluid, creamy, vibrant like a sweet red fruit syrup with soft and inviting tannins.

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## Glenelly Lady May 2018

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, PETIT VERDOT

**Stellenbosch, South Africa**

In 2003, Glenelly was bought by May-Eliane de Lencquesaing, who for over 30 years, had been the owner of the classed growth Bordeaux, Château Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande in Pauillac. Named after her, Lady May is Glenelly's flagship wine. Expect to taste flavours of cassis, blackcurrant, dark cherry, a touch of graphite and delicate, spicy plum fruit. Fresh and vibrant, Lady May is the definitive introduction to Glenelly's terroir.

## Passorosso Etna Rosso 2017

NERELLO MASCALESE

**Tuscany, Italy**

The winery sits at about a thousand meters of altitude above the small wine town of Passopisciaro on the northern slope of Mount Etna, an active volcano in northeastern Sicily. At Passopisciaro, Andrea Franchetti focuses on the native grape Nerello Mascalese and its various expressions of terroir and altitudes through a series of crus or Contrade. Nerello Mascalese is native to the Mount Etna region and is often compared to Pinot Noir due to its light color, high acidity, and elegant structure.

## Monte Campo Amarone Valpolicella 2018

CORVINA

**Veneto, Italy**

Amarone needs no introduction and is widely recognized as one of Italy's iconic red wines. The process used to make Amarone is known as *appassimento*, in which the harvested grapes are air-dried in a temperature and humidity-controlled room for about three months. The resulting grapes lose much of their natural water, and shrivel, looking a bit like raisins resulting in a powerful wine of almost 16% alcohol content and more.
