# Chicken Kebab

Fire up the grill on World Kebab Day (10 July) and get ready these flavourful chicken kebabs. Marinated in aromatic spices and cooked to a lightly charred finish, they are perfect for sharing with family and friends.

## Ingredients:

- ✓ 500g boneless chicken (thigh preferred), cut into chunks
- ✓ 3 tbsp plain yoghurt
- ✓ 1 tbsp lemon juice
- ✓ 1 tbsp olive oil
- ✓ 3 cloves garlic (minced)
- ✓ 1 tsp grated ginger
- ✓ 1 tsp paprika
- ✓ 1 tsp cumin powder
- ✓ 1 tsp coriander powder
- ✓ ½ tsp turmeric
- ✓ 1 tsp garam masala
- ✓ Salt and pepper to taste

## Optional:

- ✓ Capsicum, cut into chunks
- ✓ Onion wedges
- ✓ Cherry tomatoes
- ✓ Fresh coriander for garnish

## Instructions:

1. In a bowl, mix yoghurt, lemon juice, olive oil, garlic, ginger, and all the spices until well combined.
2. Add the chicken and coat evenly. Cover and marinate for at least 1 hour, or overnight for deeper flavour.
3. Thread the chicken onto skewers, alternating with vegetables if using.
4. Grill over medium heat for 12–15 minutes, turning occasionally, until the chicken is cooked through and lightly charred.
5. Alternatively, cook in a preheated oven at 200°C for 20–25 minutes, or pan-fry until fully cooked.
6. Serve warm, garnished with fresh coriander if desired.
